

Harrison Happenings December 9, 2008

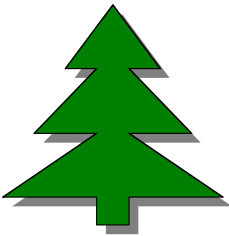
Special Thanks from Mrs. Bannon
